Subject: Geargrinders 2023 Report to the Board and 2024 Budget Approval Request

2023 Report

In 2023, the Geargrinders Road Rally Program put on ten road rallies and averaged **19 entries per rally**, slightly exceeding the goal of **18**.

The attached Geargrinders Budget 2023 yearend actual report shows that the season ended with a **profit of \$199**, a bit into positive territory compared to the budget expectation of a \$133 loss. It was a "better than last year" rally season in both attendance and profit.

Looking back

Procedures implemented in 2020 continued through the 2023 rally season.

Online registration using MotorsportsReg is required. Check-in is virtual using SpeedWaiver to sign required waivers and email to distribute rally information.

The Richta GPS Checkpoints app provides timing and scoring.

Season Tickets continued to be very popular in 2023. A Season



Ticket included entry in nine of the ten rallies (excluded Oregon Trailblazer). Nine teams purchased Season Tickets. In addition, four teams purchased a Series Pass, which included entry in all six Saturday Series rallies plus the Rally School. The savings and other incentives (same car number and start time at each event) made the Season Ticket and Series Pass very popular. These prepaid entries provided a guaranteed number of entries. and they promoted club membership since you must be a member to purchase one

The two events with the most entries were the first and the next to last of the season. The Rally School in February had 27 entries. The Ghouls Gambol Rally had 25 entries. The six events in the Saturday Rally Series averaged 19.5 entries per rally.

The Mountains to the Sea Rally was held in September the Saturday after Labor Day. Only 16 teams entered the rally. Without the attraction of an after-rally BBQ party around a beach fire, interest in this event has fallen since the pandemic. Expect some exciting changes with this event in 2024.

The Oregon Trailblazer Rally, once a Cascade tradition, last held in 2006, was offered in November. We expected no more than 10 cars, and we were close. Eleven teams entered, four cancelled before the rally started, so seven teams ran the event. Hopefully future Geargrinders rally organizers will offer this challenging trick-and-trap rally every few years.

Overall, 2023 was a successful season for the Geargrinders Road Rally Program. Slightly higher attendance producing slightly more revenue helped to bring our net for the year into positive territory. Our returning attendance has held steady.

2024 Request

Attached is the proposed 2024 Geargrinders budget and the 2024 TSD Road Rally Schedule. This budget projects the season will end with a small profit. However, everything depends on attendance. More on that soon.

Nine road rallies are planned for the 2024 season, one less than last year (no Oregon Trailblazer). The season starts with Rally School in February. The Saturday Road Rally Series includes six events, March through August. Then the Mountains to the Sea Rally in September and Ghouls Gambol in October.

The goal for 2024 continues to be to make sure Cascade rallies are affordable, easy to enter, and fun to run. Events will be well constructed, consistent in style, free from errors and ambiguities, and designed



to provide a positive experience.

The 2024 budget assumes a season average of 19.8 entries per rally. For 2023 we projected an average of 18.1 and ended the season with an average of 19.2 teams per rally.

Attendance started to decrease late in the 2021 season and continued to decline in 2022. Rally competed with many more activities as COVID restrictions decreased. High fuel prices as well as continued public health concerns also may have affected participation.

We believe these attendance expectations for 2024 are achievable. But much will depend on outreach, as well as fuel costs, competition from other activities, and public health.

Essential to encouraging attendance is making sure our events continue to comply with public health recommendations. Although public health restrictions have ended, concerns continue. Opportunities for gatherings at the beginning and ending locations as well as breaks during the rally are provided, but these gatherings are optional and not required to participate in the rally. Some folks miss this social aspect, so award of prizes on site at the rally end will be the norm rather than the exception in 2024.

Online registration through MSR remains mandatory. Check-in is virtual (via email). And GPS apps will continue to provide event scoring. These systems offer value to both participants and organizers.

Keeping entry fees low also promotes attendance. That said, entries fees have been unchanged for the last six years and probably longer than that. It is time to increase the entry fees to provide a bit more financial resource especially for event prizes. For the 2023 season, Saturday rally prices will increase by \$5 per entry. Member entry will be \$25 per entry for members and \$35 per entry for non-members. Mountains to the Sea entry will increase by \$10. Member entry will be \$60 per entry and non-member entry will be \$85. We believe Cascade's road rallies will remain accessible and affordable with these price increases.

For Cascade members, there are two other ways to make rally more affordable. The \$150 Series Pass includes entry in the Rally School and all six of the Saturday Series rallies - seven rallies for the price of six. The \$210 Season Ticket includes entry in all rallies in the Series Pass plus entry in the Mountains to the Sea Rally and Ghouls Gambol.

The Series Pass and Season Ticket packages not only make rally more affordable, they also offer benefits attractive to contestants. Register just once to be automatically entered in the rallies. Receive event

notices and rally materials before other contestants. Run the same car number with the same start time at each rally.

When asked about Saturday Series rally prizes, our rally teams have told us that candy, specifically chocolate, is an appropriate rally prize. Gift cards for coffee shops were also suggested.

In 2023 we awarded rally winners a car wash coupon and a Dutch Bros coffee card. In lieu of the coffee card, big chocolate bars were awarded to winners at Ghouls Gambol and at the Oregon Trailblazer Rally.

In 2024, we plan to continue to provide a car wash coupon along with chocolate bars at Saturday rallies. Prizes will be upscaled and more treats for all will be provided. The taste of victory is sweet, but so is finishing!

Rallymasters are essential to the rally program. We continue to recruit rallymasters. Of the ten rallies in 2023, we (Monte and Victoria) wrote six of them. We invite any rallier who is interested in learning to write a rally to contact us.



Outreach is essential to attracting new and prior participants. Promotion of Cascade's road rally events through email, social media, Auspuff, and the Cascade Geargrinders website will continue. We'll work with CSCC Marketing to identify new opportunities to improve rally event promotion.

Sustaining attendance is the key to sustaining the road rally program. We've told you in past years that a season average of about 20 cars per rally would support full reimbursement of all rally-related expenses. We came close to reaching that target in 2023. We were able to reimburse rallymasters' expenses and the program made a small profit.

An average of 25 cars per rally could fund some upscaling, such as real rally awards for class winners (instead of just carwash coupons and candy bars) and maybe dash plaques. We work toward this goal.

You can help by sharing road rally event announcements. And let us know if you identify new audience opportunities.

You can help even more by personally participating. Find a partner you like to spend time with who would enjoy a drive in the country, decide who drives and who navigates, and start the season with the Rally School Rally on Feb. 17. Then make a date for one Saturday a month to play the game that takes you places.

Cascade board members, directors, conference reps, race officials, and committee chairs are offered half off the entry fee for the Rally School Rally. Contact <u>rally@cascadesportscarclub.org</u> to get your discount.



To reiterate, the sustainability of the Cascade Geargrinders Road Rally Program depends on attendance.

Also essential to sustaining the program is consistent leadership and administration. We became Geargrinders Chair early in 2018, at a time when it seemed the program might vanish from lack of volunteers and participants. This coming season will be our seventh year as chair. It is time to start training those who will carry on after us.

Any help at all in 2024 would be most appreciated. How can you help?

- Event promotion: Promote rally events with email and social media.
- Registration: Manage event registration and virtual check-in using MotorsportReg, Excel and email.
- Prizes: Acquire event prizes and season awards, arrange perpetual trophy engraving.
- Rally financials: Report entry fee revenue and submit expense reports to the club treasurer.

We would love to focus more on rally routes and less on administrative tasks such as above. Can you help? Apply within.

And we would love to see even more Cascade members come out and rally. That's why you belong to a car club, right? You enjoy driving your car. Road rally is a fun way to enjoy driving your car in the country. Affordable fun for a carful. Play the game that takes you places.
